

EXECUTIVE ORDER #78

Relating to amending Executive Orders #67 (dated 9/29/89), #70 (dated 10/10/89), #72 (dated 11/6/89), and #77 (dated 12/15/89) to expand a Special Session of the Legislature

I TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Article IV, section 11 and Article V, section 4 of the Constitution of Wisconsin do amend Executive Order #67 (dated 9/29/89), #70 (dated 10/10/B9), #72 (dated 11/6/89), and #77 (dated 12/15/89) which required the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison on Tuesday, October 10, 1989 at 10:00 a.m., by adding to its business consideration and action upon the following specific legislative business:

 To enact legislation relating to state employe eligibility for employer contributions under the state employe health insurance program, state employe reimbursement for damaged personal articles and pay increase limitations for certain state employes.
