EXECUTIVE ORDER #79

Proclamation of an Energy Emergency


WHEREAS, the safety of households and the functioning of hospitals and other emergency services is of the highest priority and many of those households and institutions are dependent on heating fuels transported by truck; and

WHEREAS, there has been unusually cold weather in Wisconsin for this time of year and distributors' inventories of heating fuels are dangerously low;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. s. 340.01 (15s) certify that there is an energy emergency, to enable the Wisconsin Department of Transportation to waive, per Wis. Stats. s. 348.27 (8) the load limitation for vehicles carrying petroleum and liquid propane heating fuels from the date of this order through January 21, 1990.
