EXECUTIVE ORDER #108

Relating to a Special Session of the Legislature

I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Article IV, section 11 and Article V, section 4 of the Constitution of Wisconsin do require the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison, beginning on Tuesday, January 29, 1991 at 10:00 a.m. solely to consider legislation regarding crime control in the following subject areas:

- Legislation relating to minimum sentences for crimes involving dangerous weapons.
- (2) Legislation relating to gun-free school zones and providing penalties.
- (3) Legislation relating to increasing the penalty for carrying a concealed weapon.
- (4) Legislation relating to going armed in a 1st class city and providing penalties.
- (5) Legislation relating to the possession of a dangerous weapon by a child and providing penalties.
- (6) Legislation relating to creating one (1) additional circuit court in Milwaukee County, designating some circuit courts to handle primarily crimes involving violence and making appropriations.
- (7) Legislation relating to drug paraphernalia.
- (8) Legislation relating to minimum sentences for controlled substances offenses.
