EXECUTIVE ORDER #117

Relating to Transfer of Vehicle Registration Services
to Division of Motor Vehicles - La Crosse

Legislative Reference
Bureau

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation, Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) has contracted with the La Crosse County Clerk's Office for the provision of full vehicle registration services to La Crosse area residents for over 40 years; and

WHEREAS, DMV is responsible for the provision of vehicle registration services throughout the remainder of the state at existing vehicle registration and driver licensing offices; and

WHEREAS, construction of a new full service DMV motor vehicle office serving La Crosse area residents will be completed in July 1991; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle registration service and related functions formerly provided by the La Crosse County Clerk's Office will be assumed by the Division of Motor Vehicles; and

WHEREAS, this will be mutually beneficial to the La Crosse County Clerk's Office and the Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, whenever a state agency becomes responsible for functions previously administered by another governmental entity, the affected positions are included in the state classified service; and


WHEREAS, the incumbents of the affected positions may be certified for appointment to the classified service by the Administrator, Division of Merit Recruitment and Selection, Department of Employment Relations, under s. 230.15 (1m) Stats.;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 111.93(3), and by the provisions of article V, section 1 of the contract between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Employees Union, do hereby direct that:


For the incumbents of the positions currently in the La Crosse County Clerk's Office who are certified for appointment by the Administrator, Division of Merit Recruitment and Selection, their seniority dates for purposes of state service shall be that provided under the collective bargaining agreement with the Wisconsin State Employees Union and shall be based on the date they come into state service. However, the incumbents will be allowed to carry with them sick and annual leave accrued while employed with the La Crosse County Clerk's Office.
