

EXECUTIVE ORDER #155

Relating to Amending Executive Order #154 (dated 8/13/92), to Re-schedule a Special Session of the Legislature

I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Article IV, section 11 and Article V, section 4 of the Constitution of Wisconsin, do amend Executive Order #154 (dated 8/13/92), which required the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison beginning on Sentember 15 1992 by requiring the convening of a beginning on September 15, 1992, by requiring the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison, beginning on August 25, 1992, solely to consider certain nominations for appointment by the Governor requiring confirmation by the Senate.
