



EXECUTIVE ORDER #180

Relating to a Special Election for the Sixty-Eighth State Assembly District

WHEREAS, State Representative David A. Zien submitted his resignation as a State Representative for the Sixty-Eighth Assembly District, effective upon being sworn into the State Senate;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Misconsin Statute section 8.50 order that a special election be held on June 29, 1993 to fill the vacancy in the Sixty-Eighth Assembly District as described in Wis. Stats. s.4.68 for a term expiring the first Monday in January 1995; and that if a primary is necessary, it be held on June 1, 1993. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., May 4, 1993. This election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
