

EXECUTIVE ORDER #200

Proclamation of a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, natural disaster caused by severe storms and flooding beginning on June 7, 1993, in Rock, Green and Lafayette Counties in the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, additional storms with high winds and heavy rains occurred on June 29, 1993, causing additional flooding and power outages;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 166.03 (1)(b)(1), do hereby proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Rock, Green and Lafayette Counties.
