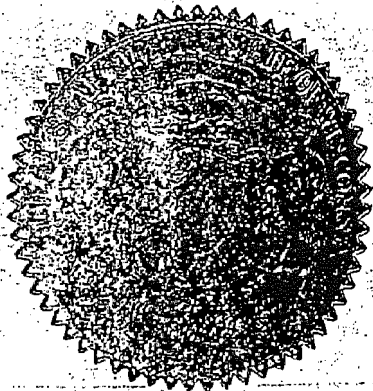
Proclamation of a State of Emergency


WHEREAS, natural disaster caused by severe storms and flooding beginning on June 7, 1993, in Lincoln and Marathon Counties in the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, additional storms with heavy rains occurring through June and July, causing additional flooding;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 166.03 (1)(b)(1), do hereby proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Lincoln and Marathon Counties.
