

## EXECUTIVE ORDER #210

## Relating to Special Election for the Fifty-Ninth Assembly District

WHEREAS, State Representative Mary E. Panzer submitted her resignation as a State Representative for the Fifty-Ninth Assembly District, effective upon taking the oath of office for the Wisconsin State Senate.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Misconsin, pursuant to Misconsin Statute section 8.50(4)(e)order that a special election be held on December 7, 1993 to fill the vacancy in the Fifty-Ninth Assembly District. A description of the boundaries of the Fifty-Ninth District, as created in <u>Prosser et. al. v. Elections Board et. al.</u>, Civil Action 92-C-0078-C (W.D. Wis. 1992), is set out in the 1991-1992 Wisconsin Statutes following s.4.005. The term will expire on the first Monday in January, 1995 and, if a primary is necessary, it shall be held on November 9, 1993. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., October 12, 1993. This election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
