EXECUTIVE ORDER #217

Relating to Amending Executive Order # 75

WHEREAS, the Governor's Committee for People with Disabilities was created by Executive Order #75 on December 1, 1989; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order #75 provided that the Council shall consist of not more than 20 members; and


WHEREAS, an additional committee member is necessary to perform the Committee's responsibilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State do hereby:

Provide that the committee shall consist of the Lieutenant Governor as a non-voting, ex-officio member and not more than 20 additional members appointed by the Governor to serve at his pleasure, selected from Wisconsin residents with disabilities and others having a demonstrated interest in the concerns of all disability groups. A majority of members shall be people with disabilities. Of the 20 members, the Governor shall appoint one member from each of the following: (1) Council on Blindness, (2) Council for the Hearing Impaired, (3) Council for the Developmentally Disabled, (4) Council on Mental Health, (5) Citizens Council on Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse, and (6) Council on Physical Disabilities.
