

EXECUTIVE ORDER #218

Relating to a proclamation that the National and State Flags be Flowm at Half Staff due to the Death of a Maukesha Police Officer, Captain James Lutz

WHEREAS, Waukesha Police officer, Captain James Lutz served the city of Waukesha in the Waukesha Police force; and

WHEREAS, on April 29, 1994, this man lost his life while serving the city of Waukesha;

NOM, THEREFORE, I, Tommy G. Thompson, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby;

Order that the National and State flags on all State buildings and State grounds be flown at half staff beginning May 6, 1994, until sundown May 6, 1994.
