Relating to Amending a Special Session of the Legislature

I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN, pursuant to Article IV, Section 11 and Article V, section 4 of the Constitution of Wisconsin, do amend Executive Order 220, and additionally require the consideration of the following legislative business:

Legislation relating to county and district fair aids and making an appropriation.
