

EXECUTIVE ORDER #233

Relating to Amending Executive Order 227 Relating to the Creation of the Commission on School Violence

WHEREAS, the Commission on School Violence was created on July 28, 1994 in Executive Order #227; and

WHEREAS, the need exists to expand membership beyond the 15 member limit.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute 14.019, do hereby:

Amend Executive Order #227 as follows:

Direct that the commission shall consist of members representing a range of educational interests to include students, teachers, principals, administrators and others involved with community violence as it impacts schools.
