



EXECUTIVE ORDER #237


Relating to a Proclamation that the National and State Flags be Flown at Half Staff due to the Death of Glendale Police Officer Ronald E. Hedbany

WHEREAS, Glendale Police Officer, Ronald E. Hedbany, served the City of Glendale in the Glendale Police force; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 1994, Officer Hedbany lost his life while in the line of duty;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tommy G. Thompson, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby;

Order that the National and State flags on all State buildings and State grounds in Milwaukee County and at the State Capitol in Madison be flown at half staff beginning November 1, 1994, at 12:00 p.m. until sundown November 4, 1994.
