

EXECUTIVE ORDER #250

Relating to a Proclamation that the National and State Flags be Flown at Half-Staff due to the Death of Former Defense Secretary and Wisconsin Congressman Les Aspin


WHEREAS, the Honorable Les Aspin served as congressman for the 1st district of Wisconsin from 1971 until 1993; and

WHEREAS, he served as Secretary of Defense from January 1993, until December 1993; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Les Aspin died on May 21, 1995;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby:

Order that the National and State flags on all State buildings and State grounds be flown at half-staff beginning May 22, 1995 until sundown on May 26, 1995.
