



EXECUTIVE ORDER #261

Relating to a Special Election for the Seventh State Senate District

WHEREAS, State Senator John R. Plewa passed away on September 13, 1995 vacating the Seventh Senate District;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute section 8.50(4): order that a special election be held on December 12, 1995 to fill the vacancy in the seventh Senate District. A description of the boundaries of the seventh Senate District as created in Prosser et. al. v. Elections Board et. al., Civil Action 92-C-0078-C (W.D. Wis. 1992) is set out in the 1993-94 Wisconsin Statutes following s. 4.005. The term will expire on the first Monday in January, 1999 and, if a primary is necessary, it shall be held on November 14, 1995. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., October 17, 1995. This election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
