

## Executive Order #275

Relating to the Temporary Evacuation of Residents of Long Term Care Facilities as a Consequence of the State of Emergency in Waupaca County

WHEREAS, a train derailed near Weyauwega, Wisconsin in the early morning hours of March 4, 1996; and

WHEREAS, this incident created a significant threat to life and property rising to the level of an emergency; and


WHEREAS, a State of Emergency was declared on March 4, 1996 pursuant to Section 166.03(1)[b]1 of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

WHEREAS, residents of three long term care facilities, Lakeview Manor, Lakeview Manor/Gateway FDD, and Weyauwega Health Care Center, have been temporarily evacuated for the duration of the emergency to other nursing homes, community based residential facilities and unlicensed facilities; and

WHEREAS, the relocation was done to protect the lives of these residents; and

WHEREAS, this temporary emergency relocation may cause potential conflicts with state licensure laws for long term care facilities and Medicaid and Medicare reimbursement.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Section 166.03(1)(b)5 of the Wisconsin Statutes, DO HEREBY ORDER that, during the State of Emergency in Waupaca County, the evacuated residents of Lakeview Manor, Lakeview Manor/Gateway FDD and Weyauwega Health Care Center be deemed to be residing at those facilities and under the licenses and certifications of those facilities for the entire time that said residents are evacuated.
