



EXECUTIVE ORDER #303

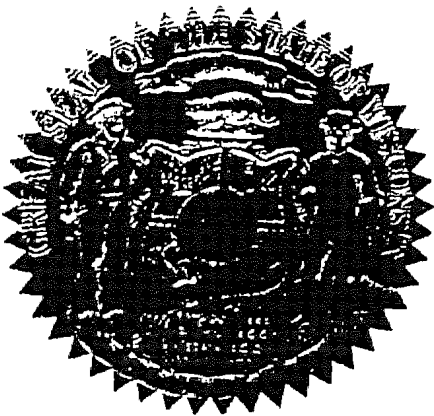
Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Late Deputy Sheriff David Demos of the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department


WHEREAS, on January 25, 1997, Deputy Sheriff David Demos was killed in the line of duty while assisting a motorist on the Milwaukee County expressway; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Demos faithfully and honorably served the people of Milwaukee County and the people of Wisconsin;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning forthwith until sundown on the day of Deputy Demos's interment.
