EXECUTIVE ORDER #313

Proclamation of a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, severe thunderstorms, flooding and high winds occurred in the State of Wisconsin on or about June 21, 1997; and

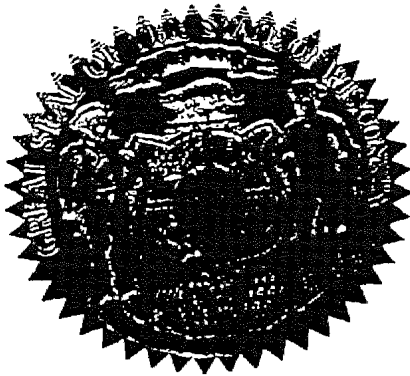
WHEREAS, such severe thunderstorms, flooding and high winds caused extensive damage in the State of Wisconsin amounting to a natural disaster; and

WHEREAS, this natural disaster affected Milwaukee, Ozaukee, and Waukesha Counties;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this state, and specifically by Section 166.03 (1)(b) 1 of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:

- (1) proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Milwaukee, Ozaukee, and Waukesha Counties; and
- (2) direct all agencies of the State of Wisconsin to assist Milwaukee, Ozaukee, and Waukesha Counties in recovering from this natural disaster.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this twenty-third day of June in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-seven.
