


EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 345

Relating to the Amendment of Executive Order No. 344

WHEREAS, a State of Emergency was declared in Executive Order No. 344 for Portage, Marathon, Waushara and Waupaca Counties in the State of Wisconsin due to extreme drought conditions caused by a lack of precipitation during the spring and summer of 1998; and

WHEREAS, Langlade County in the State of Wisconsin has also been severely affected by this drought;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by § 166.03(1)(b)1, Wis. Stats., do hereby amend Executive order No. 344 to provide that a State of Emergency exists in Langlade County and include Langlade County in the list of counties set forth in Executive Order No. 344 where water may be diverted from certain lakes and streams pursuant to the process established in that order.
