

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 351

Proclamation of a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, a tornado and associated storms swept through Door County, Wisconsin on the evening of Sunday, August 23, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the tornado and associated storms caused extensive damage to residential and commercial properties, agriculture, the power distribution system and other elements of the public service infrastructure amounting to a natural disaster;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this state, and specifically by Section 166.03 (1)(b) 1 of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:

- 1. Proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Door County; and
- 2. Direct all agencies of the State of Wisconsin to assist Door County in recovering from this natural disaster.
