

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 354

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Memory of the Late Dale Ten Haken of the Manitowoc Police Department

WHEREAS, on September 23, 1998, Officer Dale Ten Haken of the Manitowoc Police Department was killed in the line of duty during an investigatory stop; and

WHEREAS, Officer Ten Haken bravely and honorably served the people of the city of Manitowoc and the people of the State of Wisconsin;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations under the control of the State of Wisconsin beginning forthwith until sundown on the day of Officer Ten Haken's interment.
