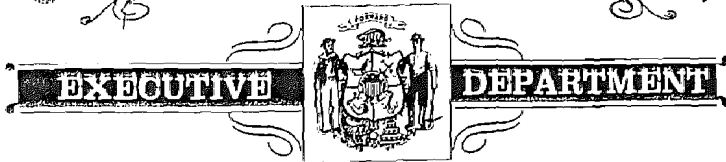

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 407

Proclamation of a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, severe storms with torrential rain occurred in Eau Claire County on September 10 and 11, 2000; and

WHEREAS, these intense storms caused extensive damage to individual homes, businesses and to public infrastructure in Eau Claire County;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Wisconsin, and specifically by Sections 166.03(1)(b)1 and 21.11(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:

1. Proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Eau Claire County; and
2. Direct all agencies of the State of Wisconsin to assist Eau Claire County.
