



EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 28

Relating to a Proclamation Regarding a Potential Emergency

WHEREAS, it has come to my attention that the events of September 11th last created potential flight safety risks for Wisconsin citizens, as well as other terrorist-induced risks yet to be determined; and

WHEREAS, the President has also recognized these risks and requested the Governor's support to the Federal Aviation Authority and those commercial airport hubs within the state where a substantial threat to airport security may exist; and

WHEREAS, threats of these potential terrorist activities are not expected to be reduced in the short-term, thus creating a great economic hardship for the citizens and local governments of this state; and

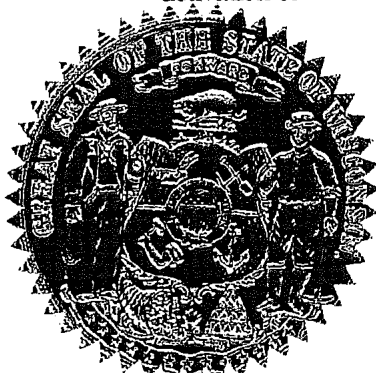
WHEREAS, additional personnel may be necessary, and an assessment is therefore required;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT McCALLUM, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the laws of this state, and specifically by Sections 166.03(1)(b)(1) and 21.11 of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:

1. Proclaim that a potential State of Emergency exists throughout the State of Wisconsin; and
2. Direct the Adjutant General and the Wisconsin Department of Military Affairs to assess this situation and determine what National Guard assets will be necessary; and
3. Direct that the Adjutant General report back to me as quickly as possible his assessment of the situation and his recommendations for activation of Wisconsin National Guard personnel.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this twenty-seventh day of September in the year two thousand and one.
