

## EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 56

## An Amendment to Executive Orders No. 53 and 54 Proclamation of a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, severe weather including heavy rains, high winds and tornadoes occurred on or about September 2, 2002, in the State of Wisconsin;

WHEREAS, heavy rains and tornado activity caused substantial property damage; and

WHEREAS, these severe weather conditions have created great hardship for the citizens and local governments of the affected counties; and

WHEREAS, additional personnel and resources are needed to expedite emergency recovery operations in the affected counties;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT McCALLUM, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this state, and specifically by Sections 21.11 (1) and 166.03 (1)(b)(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:

- 1. In addition to Rusk and Taylor Counties, I now proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Polk and Marathon Counties; and
- 2. Direct all state agencies of the State of Wisconsin to assist the above-referenced counties as appropriate in this response effort.
