

EXECUTIVE ORDER # 10

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Firefighter Carl Mack of the New Chester Fire Department

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2003, Firefighter Carl Mack died while battling a fire in Adams County; and

WHEREAS, Firefighter Carl Mack served the people of New Chester and the people of Wisconsin with distinction and honor; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Firefighter Carl Mack;

WHEREAS, Firefighter Carl Mack will be laid to rest on Saturday, April 26, 2003; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Saturday, April 26, 2003, and ending at sundown on that date.
