Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Late Deputy Bruce Williams of the Green Lake County Sheriff's Department


WHEREAS, on Sunday, October 19, 2003, Green Lake County Sheriff's Deputy Bruce Williams was killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Bruce Williams served the people of Green Lake County and the people of Wisconsin with distinction and honor; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Deputy Bruce Williams;

WHEREAS, Deputy Bruce Williams will be laid to rest on Friday, October 24, 2003;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Friday, October 24, 2003 and ending at sunset on that date.
