

## **EXECUTIVE ORDER #4**

Relating to a Special Election for the Eighteenth Assembly District, the Seventh Senate District, and the Twenty-fourth Senate District

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable Antonio Riley, submitted his resignation as a State Representative for the Eighteenth Assembly District, effective January 28, 2003;

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable Richard A. Grobschmidt, submitted his resignation as a State Senator for the Seventh Senate District, effective January 13, 2003;

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable Kevin Shibilski, submitted his resignation as a State Senator for the Twenty-fourth Senate District, effective January 7, 2003;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jim Doyle, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to section 8.50(4) of the Wisconsin Statutes, order that a special election be held on April 29, 2003 to fill the vacancies in the Eighteenth Assembly District, the Seventh Senate District and the Twenty-fourth Senate District. A description of the boundaries of the Eighteenth Assembly District, Seventh Senate District and the Twenty-fourth Senate District as created in the combined cases of Baumgart et al. v. Wendelberger, Case No. 01-C-0121 (E.D. Wis. 2002) and Jensen et al. v. Wendelberger, Case No. 02-C-0366 (E.D. Wis. 2002) are set out in the 2001-02 Wisconsin Statutes following section 4.005. The terms for the Eighteenth Assembly and the Twenty-fourth Senate Districts will expire on the first Monday in January, 2005. The term for the Seventh Senate District will expire on the first Monday in January, 2007. If a primary is necessary, it shall be held on April 1, 2003. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on February 19, 2003 and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 P.M., March 4, 2003 in the office of the State Elections Board. This election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
