

EXECUTIVE ORDER # 46

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Private First Class Ryan Jerabek of the United States Marine Corps Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom


WHEREAS, on April 6, 2004, Private First Class Ryan Jerabek of Hobart. Wisconsin, a member of the United States Marine Corps, 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines, 1st Marine Division, I Marine Expeditionary Force was killed in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Private First Class Ryan Jerabek provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Private First Class Ryan Jerabek; and

WHEREAS, Private First Class Ryan Jerabek will be laid to rest on Friday, April 16, 2004;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Friday, April 16, 2004, and ending at sunset on that date.
