

EXECUTIVE ORDER # 48

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Specialist Michael A. McGlothin of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2004, Specialist Michael A. McGlothin, of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, a member of the United States Army, 115th Forward Support Battalion, Division Support Command, 1st Cavalry Division, was killed when an explosive device exploded near his patrol in Baghdad, Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Specialist Michael A. McGlothin provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Specialist Michael A. McGlothin; and

WHEREAS, Specialist Michael A. McGlothin will be laid to rest in Wisconsin on Tuesday, April 27, 2004;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Tuesday, April 27, 2004, and ending at sunset on that date.
