

EXECUTIVE ORDER # 102

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Specialist Kyle Hemauer of the Virginia Army National Guard Who Lost His Life During Operation Enduring Freedom


WHEREAS, on May 23, 2005, Specialist Kyle Hemauer, a member of 3rd Battalion, 116th Infantry Regiment, 29th Infantry Division, Virginia Army National Guard, died during service in Afghanistan; and

WHEREAS, Specialist Kyle Hemauer provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Specialist Kyle Hemauer; and

WHEREAS, Specialist Kyle Hemauer will be laid to rest on Thursday, June 2, 2005;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on June 2, 2005, and ending at sunset on that date.
