

EXECUTIVE ORDER # 103

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Sergeant Mark Maida of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom


WHEREAS, on May 26, 2005, Sergeant Mark Maida, a member of 2nd Squadron, 11th Armored Cavalry Regiment, United States Army, died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Mark Maida provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Sergeant Mark Maida; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Mark Maida will be laid to rest on Saturday, June 4, 2005;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on June 4, 2005, and ending at sunset on that date.
