

EXECUTIVE ORDER # 114

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Specialist John Tollefson of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom


WHEREAS, on July 27, 2005, Specialist John Tollefson, a member of 411th Military Police Company, 720th Military Police Battalion, 89th Military Police Brigade, United States Army, lost his life while serving on active duty in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Specialist John Tollefson provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Specialist John Tollefson; and

WHEREAS, a funeral service for Specialist John Tollefson will be held on Tuesday, August, 9, 2005;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on August 9, 2005, and ending at sunset on that date.
