

EXECUTIVE ORDER # 122

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Sergeant First Class Trevor Diesing of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom


WHEREAS, on August 25, 2005, Sergeant First Class Trevor Diesing, a member of Special Operations Command, United States Army, died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant First Class Trevor Diesing provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Sergeant First Class Trevor Diesing; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Sergeant First Class Trevor Diesing on Saturday, September 10, 2005;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on September 10, 2005, and ending at sunset on that date.
