

## **EXECUTIVE ORDER # 128**

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff in Remembrance of Rosa Parks

WHEREAS, on October 24, 2005, Rosa Parks passed away at the age of ninety-two; and

WHEREAS, Rosa Parks courageously defied injustice and by doing so helped to inspire the modern civil rights movement; and

WHEREAS, the President has directed that the flag of the United States be lowered to half-staff at all public buildings and grounds in honor of Rosa Parks on the day of her interment;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Wednesday, November 2, 2005, and ending at sunset on that date.
