

EXECUTIVE ORDER # 142

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Lance Corporal Adam VanAlstine of the United States Marine Corps Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom


WHEREAS, on February 25, 2006, Lance Corporal Adam VanAlstine, a member of 3rd Battalion, 7th Marine Regiment, 1st Marine Division, United States Marine Corps, was killed during enemy action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Adam VanAlstine provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Lance Corporal Adam VanAlstine; and

WHEREAS, a funeral service for Lance Corporal Adam VanAlstine will be held on Monday, March 6, 2006;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on March 6, 2006, and ending at sunset on that date.
