

## EXECUTIVE ORDER # 166

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Lieutenant Arnie Wolff of the Green Bay Fire Department

WHEREAS, on August 13, 2006, Lieutenant Arnie Wolff died while battling a fire in the City of Green Bay; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Arnie Wolff served the people of Green Bay and the people of Wisconsin with distinction and honor; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Lieutenant Arnie Wolff;

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Arnic Wolff will be laid to rest on Friday, August 18, 2006; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Friday, August 18, 2006, and ending at sundown on that date.
