

EXECUTIVE ORDER # 215

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Captain Derek Dobogai of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom

WHEREAS, on August 22, 2007, Captain Derek Dobogai, a member of the 2nd Battalion, 35th Infantry Regiment, 3rd Infantry Brigade Combat Team, 25th Infantry Division, died as a result of injuries sustained while conducting combat operations in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Captain Derek Dobogai provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Captain Derek Dobogai; and

WHEREAS, Captain Derek Dobogai will be laid to rest on Monday, September 3, 2007;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on September 3, 2007, and ending at sunset on that date.
