EXECUTIVE ORDER # 235

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Private First Class Timothy Hanson of the United States Army Who Lost His Life While Serving His Country

WHEREAS, on January 7, 2008, Private First Class Timothy Hanson, a member of the 1st Battalion, 15th Infantry Regiment, 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 3rd Infantry Division, United States Army, died while serving his country in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Private First Class Timothy Hanson provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Private First Class Hanson; and

WHEREAS, Private First Class Hanson will be laid to rest on Wednesday, January 16, 2008;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on January 16, 2008, and ending at sunset on that date.
