


## **EXECUTIVE ORDER # 321**

## Relating to the Revocation of a Proclamation Declaring a Public Health Emergency

**WHEREAS,** on April 30, 2009, by Executive Order No. 280, I declared that a state of public health emergency, as defined in Section 166.02(7) of the Wisconsin Statutes, existed for the State of Wisconsin, and

**WHEREAS**, the public health emergency that then existed in the state due to the presence of the H1N1 influenza virus has abated;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jim Doyle,** Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Wisconsin, and specifically by section 166.03 (2009) of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby revoke the proclamation of emergency contained in Executive Order No. 280.
