

EXECUTIVE ORDER # 322

Relating to a Declaration of a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, on July 22 and July 23, 2010, severe thunderstorms and heavy rains caused flash flooding in Milwaukee County, forcing persons from their homes, damaging roadways and other structures, and causing extensive power outages; and

WHEREAS, area emergency responders from fire, law enforcement, and emergency medical services responded to these storms, including staff from Wisconsin Emergency Management, State Patrol, Department of Health Services, and the Department of Natural Resources; and

WHEREAS, additional personnel and resources are needed to expedite the response and recovery operations in the affected area;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jim Doyle, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this state, and specifically by Section 323.10 of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:

- Declare that a State of Emergency exists in Milwaukee County resulting from the disaster; and
- Direct all state agencies of the State of Wisconsin to assist the above referenced county as appropriate in this response and recovery effort.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this twenty-third day of July in the year two thousand and ten.
