

EXECUTIVE ORDER #7


Relating to a Requirement that Each Administrative Department and Independent Agency Create a Team to Assist the Commission on Waste, Fraud and Abuse

WHEREAS, Executive Order #2 created the Commission on Waste, Fraud and Abuse with the following purposes:

- a. To identify waste, fraud and abuse in state government programs and state appropriations and recommend solutions.
- b. To obtain and review all budget documentation for each state agency, including detailed information regarding the appropriations and programs administered and the related personnel costs.
- c. To advise the governor about the long and short-term impact of the Commission's recommendations on state appropriations, efforts to make government smaller and more efficient, and ongoing economic development initiatives;

WHEREAS, assistance from state agencies and departments is necessary for the achievement of the Commission's goals of finding waste, fraud and abuse in state government;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State do hereby require that the appointed heads of each administrative department and independent agency create a team within their departments and agencies to assist the Commission on Waste, Fraud and Abuse to identify waste, fraud and abuse within each agency and recommend steps to eliminate waste, fraud and abuse.
