

EXECUTIVE ORDER #101

Relating to the Governor's Homeland Security Council

WHEREAS, Wisconsin must be prepared to protect its citizens, critical infrastructure, and key assets from any possible terrorist threats; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Homeland Security Council was created by Governor Doyle through Executive Orders #7, 143, and 268, and recreated by Governor Walker through Executive Order #6 to coordinate the efforts of state and local officials with regard to prevention of, and response to, potential threats to the homeland security of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, adding members to the Governor's Homeland Security Council is now appropriate, given evolving threats and conditions, and in order to achieve a higher level of preparedness.

NOW, THEREFORE I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, specifically Wisconsin Statutes § 14.019, do hereby:

- 1. Declare that this Order replaces the provision of Executive Order #6 recreating the Governor's Homeland Security Council as created by Governor Doyle's Executive Orders #7, 143, and 268 and amend the Governor's Homeland Security Council as follows:
 - a. The Council shall consist of sixteen members appointed by the Governor to serve at the pleasure of the Governor; and
 - b. The Governor shall designate one member of the Council as chair to serve in that capacity at the pleasure of the Governor; and
 - c. The Council's mission shall be to advise the Governor and coordinate the efforts of state and local officials with regard to prevention of, and response to, potential threats to the homeland security of Wisconsin; and
 - d. The Council shall submit periodic reports to the Governor; and
 - e. The Council shall submit a final report to the Governor upon the Governor's request; and
 - f. The Council shall dissolve when the Governor accepts the Council's final report.
