

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2017 Wisconsin Act 42 [2017 Senate Bill 172]

Administration of Vaccines by Pharmacy Students

Previous law allows a person who is a pharmacy student who has completed at least two years of pharmacy studies and a person who has completed pharmacy studies but whose application for licensure as a pharmacist is pending to administer a vaccine to a person who is at least **18** years old if the pharmacy student administers the vaccine under the direct supervision of a licensed pharmacist and certain other requirements are met. 2017 Wisconsin Act 42 allows a pharmacy student to administer a vaccine to a person who is at least **six** years old, provided all other current law requirements are met.
