2017 Wisconsin Act 64 [2017 Assembly Bill 323]

Woodchuck Hunting

2017 Wisconsin Act 64 requires the Department of Natural Resources to establish a yearround open season for hunting and trapping woodchucks, with no bag or possession limit. Under the Act, a landowner or occupant, and any member of his or her family, or someone else with the consent of the landowner or occupant, may also take a woodchuck at any time by means of live trapping with box traps in areas where the discharge of a firearm is illegal.
