**Mike Johnson Life Care and
Early Intervention Services
Grants**

2021 WISCONSIN ACT 226

The Department of Health Services (DHS) awards grants, called “Mike Johnson Life Care and Early Intervention Services Grants,” to applying organizations for HIV-related services, including needs assessments, assistance in procuring services, counseling and therapy, home care services and supplies, advocacy, case management services, and early intervention services.

The act both clarifies that only AIDS service organizations designated by DHS may receive certain grants for HIV services, and expands the Mike Johnson Life Care and Early Intervention Services Grant program so recipients may use funds to provide access to clinical services and laboratory testing for individuals who are at risk for HIV to obtain access to pre-exposure prophylaxis.
