2017 SENATE BILL 461

2017 Senate Bill 461 modifies the membership requirement for incorporating a Red Arrow Club by expanding the types of military service that may qualify a person to be a member of a Red Arrow Club and by removing a reference in current law to persons who were members of the 32nd Division during World War I.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 modifies the bill in order to retain the reference in current law to persons who were members of the 32nd Division during World War I.

BILL HISTORY

Senator Testin offered Senate Amendment 1 on January 9, 2018. On February 8, 2018, the Senate Committee on Workforce Development, Military Affairs and Senior Issues recommended adoption of the amendment on a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0, and recommended passage of the bill as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
