2017 SENATE BILL 760

2017 Senate Bill 760 modifies state statutes related to vital records and collection of statistics. It generally changes the terminology to refer to vital records as “records” rather than “certificates” or “documents,” and modifies the statutes to allow the use of electronic records through an online system of vital records.

SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Substitute Amendment 1 contains most of the same provisions as the bill but removes some of the terminology changes for certain vital records.

BILL HISTORY

Senator Olsen offered Senate Substitute Amendment 1 on February 12, 2018. On February 15, 2018, the Senate Committee on Economic Development, Commerce and Local Government unanimously recommended adoption of the amendment, and unanimously recommended passage of the bill, as amended.
