2019 Senate Bill 510

Senate Amendment 1

2019 SENATE BILL 510

The Little Plover River Watershed Enhancement Project was initiated in 2017. The Village of Plover received a \$100,000 grant for the project under the 2017 Biennial Budget Act.

2019 Senate Bill 510 appropriates \$100,000 from the environmental fund in the current fiscal biennium and requires the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to provide those funds as a second grant to the Village of Plover for continued implementation of wetland restoration and watershed enhancement designed to increase the flow of the Little Plover River.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

During the 2019-21 and 2021-23 fiscal biennia, Senate Amendment 1 requires DNR and the Village of Plover to monitor the flow of the Little Plover River and to annually report stream flow data for the river to the Joint Committee on Finance and relevant standing committees of the Legislature.

BILL HISTORY

On January 15, 2020, upon motions made and seconded by Senator Miller and Senator Hansen, the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and Energy voted unanimously to introduce Senate Amendment 1. The committee then voted to recommend adoption of the amendment and passage of the bill, as amended, both on unanimous votes.
