2021 Assembly Bill 337

Assembly Amendment 1

2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 337

2021 Assembly Bill 337 authorizes the use of a prefilled epinephrine syringe, in the same manner as authorized under current law for an epinephrine auto-injector in schools and other settings. The bill also specifies that the Department of Health Services or a person with prescribing authority may issue a standing order to dispense epinephrine to persons who have completed the required training for administration of epinephrine.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 adds an authorization for the administration of a prefilled epinephrine syringe in a current law provision, not addressed by the bill, that authorizes administration of an epinephrine auto-injector by certain school staff.

BILL HISTORY

Representative Sortwell offered Assembly Amendment 1 on June 23, 2021. On October 19, 2021, the Assembly Committee on Health recommended adoption of the amendment and passage of the bill, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 13; Noes, 0.
